

# Second Circular, including Call for Papers

The 14<sup>th</sup> International Saga Conference Uppsala 9<sup>th</sup>–15<sup>th</sup> August, 2009

Dear colleagues and friends,

This is the second general circular concerning The 14<sup>th</sup> International Saga Conference in Uppsala 2009. The Conference will be held in the University Main Building. We are planning for four plenary lectures (45 minutes each including discussion), three parallel sessions (30 minutes for each paper including discussion) and one round table discussion (60 minutes). The sessions are eleven, including one open. There will be a five minute break between each paper. You may find further information about the sessions and the conference at www.saga.nordiska.uu.se.

We will begin registration at Språkvetenskapligt Centrum (Centre for Language Studies in the English Park Campus. Centre for the Humanities), Thunbergsvägen 3 L, Uppsala, on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> August, between 17.00 and 19.00. Registration will proceed on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> August at Uppsala University Main Building between 8.30 and 9.45.

Included in the conference fee are lunch meals and coffee on conference days (i.e. not on Wednesday), the reception on Monday evening, and two evening tours (Tuesday and Thursday).

Non-participating visitors are welcome at the reception and the two evening tours, and may register to attend a day tour and the evening banquet.

If you are planning to give a paper at the Saga Conference in Uppsala 2009, please indicate this in the preliminary registration form on our home page. Abstracts of proposed papers must be submitted no later than 1<sup>st</sup> August 2008 to be considered. Acceptances will be mailed out before the Third Circular (see below). Final papers should not be longer than 10 pages and must be submitted no later than 1<sup>st</sup> May 2009. Abstracts should be e-mailed to saga@nordiska.uu.se. The abstracts and accepted papers will be placed on our homepage. (There will also be a pre print publication.) Detailed information about paper format will be announced in the Third Circular.
